What is a Case Clinic?

A structured, peer-support process rooted in social learning theory.

One participant presents a real, current challenge from their practice, while others support through **deep listening, reflection, and dialogue** - not to prescribe solutions, but to generate insight.

Widely used in Communities of Practice for their ability to **surface collective wisdom, deepen trust and turn reflection into action.**

Case Clinic structure

• Case sharing	Vesa introduces the challenge	5'
• We ask clarifying Qs	<i>Can you tell me more about...?</i>	15'
• We share experiences	<i>This makes me think of...</i>	10'
• We give advice	<i>You could try...</i>	15'
• We all reflect		15'

The Case Clinic Question from Vesa:

While increasing its impact?"*
