- What is it? Mechanism that funds early warning services in LDCs and SIDS
- Why is it needed? To bridge the capacity gap in a coherent manner
- How will Members benefit? Over 30 already benefit and more to come

Innovative finance: Systematic Observations Financing Facility (SOFF)

- What is it? Provision of equitable, predictable, and performance-based finance and technical assistance that recognizes the global value of local observations
- Why is it needed? Current "aid" financing of developing countries observations is unsustainable, unfair and inequitable
- How will Members benefit? Achieve compliance with GBON and therefore better forecasts and climate products for everyone
- Where do we stand? Initial concept phase. Launch at COP 26, December 2020?
