

DIRECTOR OF METEOROLOGY

- The Ministry Of Transportation and Telecommunications (MTT) Bahrain Meteorological Directorate (BMD) is the authorized Government Organization for all meteorological activities in the country.
- The history of BMD began in 1902, when the first Meteorological records were made, and our meteorological archives go back to that date.
- The Kingdom joined the world Meteorological Organization (WMO) the specialized Meteorological agency of United Nations in 1980. In 2001, the Kingdom was elected as president of regional Association II (Asia).
- The BMD contributes to Bahrain's national social and economic by providing critical weather services.
- The BMD is responsible for the supply of meteorological advice and information, both historical and of a forecast nature, to the public and private sectors in Bahrain.
- It is also responsible for carrying out research into meteorological and related subjects for Bahrain and the region.


Objectives

- Meet the needs of future Bahraini generations for reliable and homogenous climatological records.












Radar Image (Rain Intensity)


