RECOMMENDATIONS FOR REVISION OF THE WMO CAPACITY DEVELOPMENT STRATEGY

- Ensure that WMO Regional Training Centers, WMO training partners and WMO specialized Centres
 can increase their support
- The EC Capacity Development Panel (CDP) will have direct reporting responsibilities to the Executive Council via the PAC and TAC
- The key interactions for receiving input and providing guidance will be with the Regional Associations (RAs), the WMO Regional Training Centers (RTCs) and the Technical Commissions.
- The composition of the CDP will attempt to be representative of both the RAs and the TCs to the extent possible.
- Co-opt experts from WMO and development partners



Interactions

- Regional Training Centers: The future evolution of RTC criteria, recommendations
 on designation and reconfirmation or decommissioning, and oversight of external
 assessments of RTCs will be the responsibility of the CDP and its Expert Teams.
- Technical Commissions, Research Board and Hydrological Coordination Panel: Each TC meeting will include evolving capacity development needs as one of its key agenda items and an important category of outcomes and recommendations. These will inform the agenda of upcoming CDP meetings
