

Pre-activity for Webinar for RWC Kenya and RWC Tanzania Operations

The webinar for RWC Kenya and RWC Tanzania Operations which will be held on August 13, 2020 is a follow-up session to the previous webinar, WDQMS Webinar for Regional WIGOS Centers in RA I - EAC which was held on July 2, 2020.


The webinar is preceded by an activity (simulation) where each RWC host, i.e. KMD and TMA, is requested to open a new ticket in Incident Management System (JIRA ECMWF).

This pre-activity needs to be completed prior to the webinar.

In the following the guidance on how to open a new ticket/to raise a new issue in the Incident Management System for Regional WIGOS Centres (RWCs) is provided:

- 1. Login to IMS, https://jira.ecmwf.int/projects/RWC/
- 2. Click "Create" in the header
- 3. Fill out the form with details of the issue to be raised

Example 1, FP of RWC Tanzania will report an availability issue of surface observations in Musoma station, WIGOS ID: 0-20000-0-63733. WDQMS webtool (https://wdqms.wmo.int/) shows that the issue has occurred for a long period. Below is a screenshot from the webtool.



The form could be filled as follows:

Station: Musoma



Exampe 2, FP of RWC Kenya will report an availability issue of upper-air observations in Dagoretti Corner station, WIGOS ID: 0-20000-0-63741. WDQMS webtool (https://wdqms.wmo.int/) shows that the issue has occurred for a long period. Below is a screenshot from the webtool.



The form could be filled as follows:



Component: RWC Kenya and Tanzania

Description: Availability issue of upper air observations over a long period

Priority: Low

Example 3, FP of RWC Tanzania will open a ticket regarding a station in Kenya, shown in the WDQMS webtool but there is no corresponding station ID in OSCAR/Surface. It is indicated as yellow dot as shown below.



The form could be filled as follows:

Station : Unknown

Project : Incident Management System

Country: Kenya WIGOS ID: 63612

Summary: 07082020-Kenya-unknown-no match in OSCAR/Surface

Component: RWC Kenya and Tanzania

Description: A station shown in the webtool but indicated as unknown station

Priority: Medium

4. RWC is responsible for reviewing and evaluating the tickets assigned to them and for deciding whether to update the ticket to an incident, especially if the ticket is opened by a user other than RWC itself. If it is agreed to update into an incident, it must be assigned to relevant FPs.
