





DEVELOPING ONLINE COURSE MATERIALS


especially for the practical/hands-on sessions. The online assessment and evaluation are other challenges that existed

What Works/Achievements


- Developing e-learning since 2013, most residential courses transformed into full online learning during the pandemic
- Conducted online seminars (OGD) since 2014. OGD#100 attended by 1700 participants
- Kick-off the BMKG Corporate University attended by 198 BMKG stations
- Adjusted business process based on studies on e-learning implementation
- Implementing more online new learning, and collaboration tools and platforms
- Effective Staffing strategy during pandemic (WFH/WFA employee numbers)

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Challenges


- Designing skills training to online (ie. training about instrumentations, software runnings, etc.)
- Developing online course materials, especially for practical/hands-on sessions.
- Conducting the online assessment and evaluation
- SIDS geographical aspects show limited infrastructures for supporting online learning events
- Conducting comprehensive Training Need Analysis for the RA V Member Countries, especially the online-based TNA
- SME exchanges with other RTC/ NMHS or assistance in delivering learning methods and activities

Findings from Studies


- SME/ instructors/ trainers do need assistance in designing and delivering learning methods and activities, esp. in hands-on activities
- A case study about Self Regulated Learning Indeks in Ina RTC shows that students have high independency in online training (1 online) training)
- Students and trainers readiness level are various/ different in adapting to new learning tools/platforms
- duration of the synchronous sessions does affect students learning focus and motivation
- longer duration of synchronous, as well as login duration time to LMS, do not always mean the higher value
