Initial Survey

Following an Executive Council decision (EC-70) to review the Basic Instruction Package for Meteorologists and Meteorological Technicians (BIP-M and BIP-MT), a global survey was conducted during 2018 to provide initial input to the review process.



BIPs Review Meeting

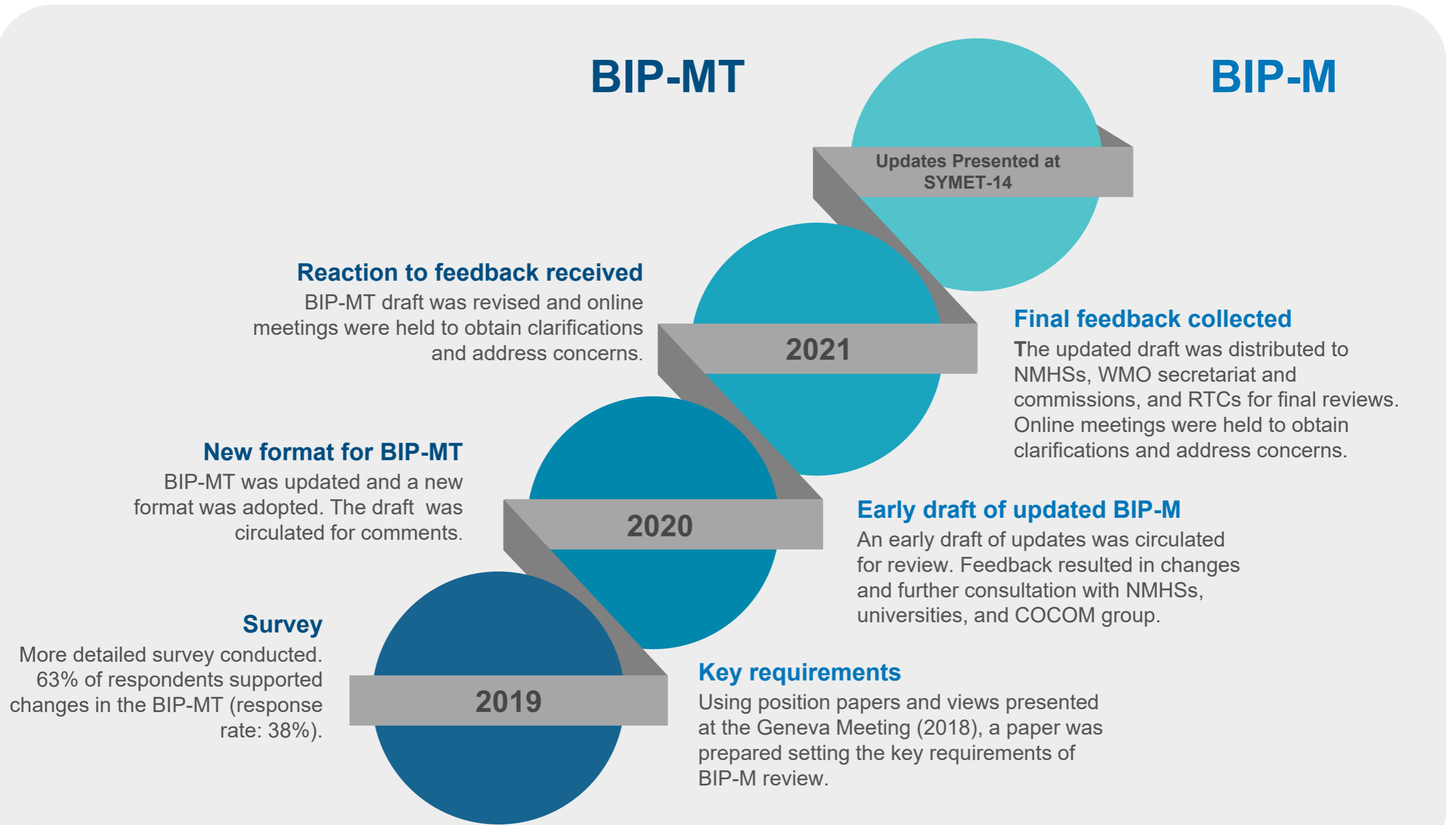
The results of this survey were presented and discussed during a meeting held in Geneva 27-28 November 2018. The meeting agreed that review teams should be formed to examine and update the BIPs. Chris Webster (New Zealand) and Winifred Jordaan (South Africa) were appointed to co-chair the review process, which started by setting up 2 working groups to review the BIP-M and the BIP-MT.



Consultation

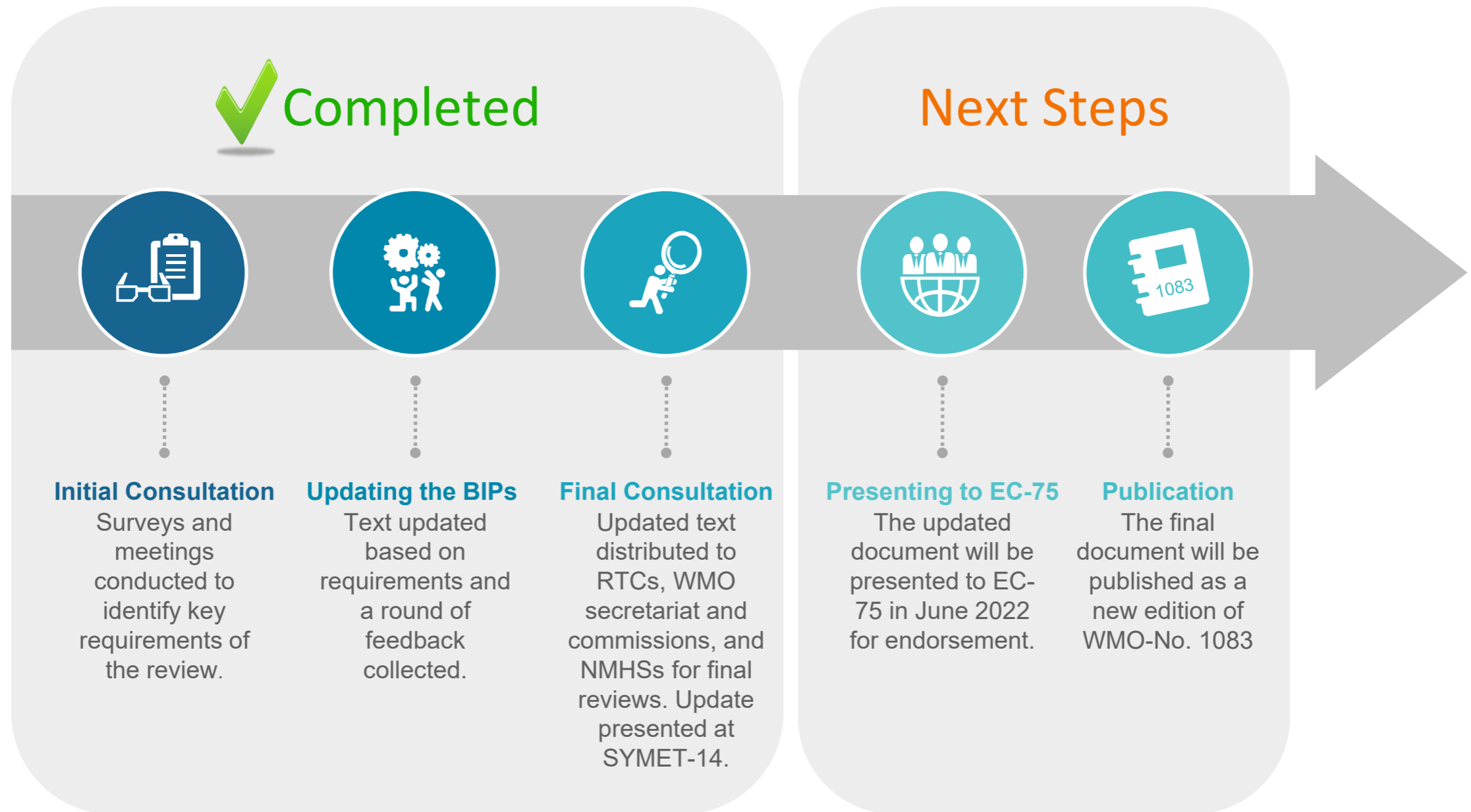
From 2019 to 2021 Working Groups lead by Steven Callaghan (United Kingdom) and Coleen Rae (South Africa) reviewed and updated BIP-M and BIP-MT (respectively) in consultation with Members, through additional survey, feedback requests, and online meetings to procure clarifications and address concerns. Final draft of updated BIPs was presented at SYMET-14.

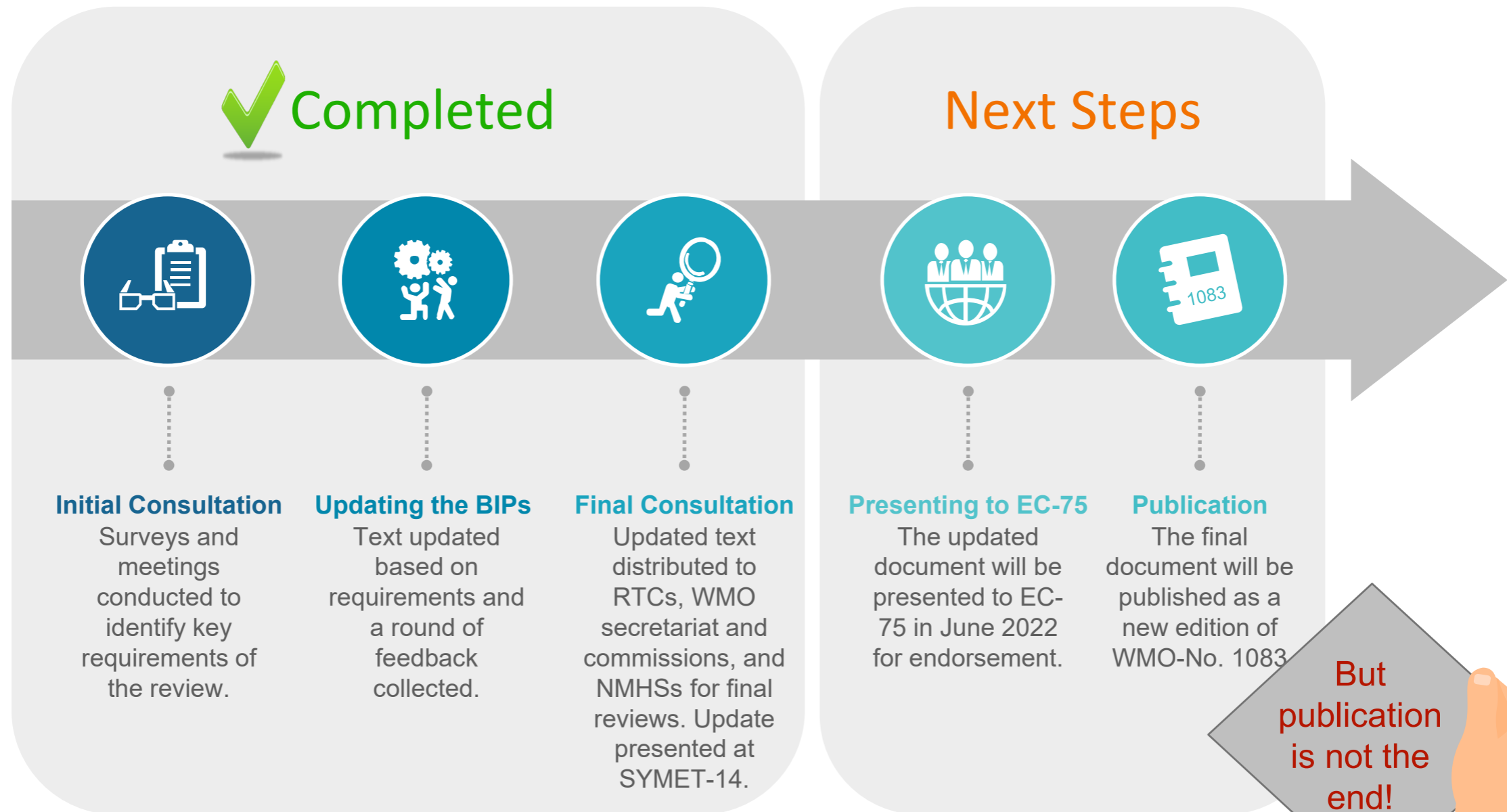
