

- The WMO Gender Action Plan 2024-2027 **was approved** last year during Cg-19

- Before the presentation of the document, the Secretariat invited all Members and Experts to attend a Gender Breakfast to discuss the activities proposed in the plan. More than 120 staff/Members/experts participated

ONE OF OUR MAIN GOAL IS TO RAISE VISIBILITY OF OUR MEMBERS, ESPECIALLY FOR WOMEN

- Sept 2023 (NYC) "Women Rise for All" lunch organized by DSG Aminah Mohamed, Prof. Karnawati (PR Indonesia) represented WMO
- Dec 2023 (COP28) –Prof. Karnawati spoke on a panel for SDGs, on a panel organized by UN Women, and joined WMO Experts from Senegal and Spain on a panel for gender

- Posting news on WMO website on gender activities done by our Members (picture of our colleagues in Libya, celebrating IWD) and postcast on women in NMHS










SECRETARIAT - GENDER AWARENESS

- With the knowledge management team of WMO, we are preparing short webinars on gender, inclusivity, parity, diversity and gender bias
- Harassment course is now <u>mandatory</u> for all staff
- A comprehensive sexual harassment policy has been drafted and submitted to SG for approval
- A training "Overcoming Unconscious Bias" is available for free, for all staff, recommended especially to hiring managers
- Feb 2024 3 WMO participated at the session Office of the Victims' Rights Advocate (OVRA) Training of Trainers: module on the implementation of the victim-centred approach. The goal is to have all WMO staff trained at the end of the year.
