<p><a href="#">Draft Resolution 6.1/1</a> Major Programmes and programme-based approach</p> <p><u>Decides</u> that the Strategic and Operating Plans for the twentieth financial period and the related Maximum Expenditures and Biennial Budgets shall include information regarding the alignment of the Results-Based Approach with the description and implementation activities of Major Programmes;</p> <p><u>Requests</u> regional associations and the <b>Capacity Development Panel</b> to finalize refinement of the respective Programme descriptions by the eightieth session of the Executive Council to serve the purpose described above;</p> <p><u>Requests</u> the Technical Coordination Committee to keep under review the further development of the programme description and planned activities, in particular, ensuring the proper coordination of activities that contribute to multiple Long-Term Goals;</p> <p><u>Requests</u> the Policy Advisory Committee to keep under review the alignment between the programmatic activities defined in the Major Programmes and planning and budgeting processes;</p> <p>Requests the Secretary-General:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) To ensure an alignment between the WMO Strategic and Operating Plans for the twentieth financial period and the Major Programmes;</li> <li>2) To present information regarding the financial elements of the Major Programmes when presenting the Maximum Expenditures and Biennial Budgets.</li> </ol>	<p>In progress</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• ETR collected the expected inputs from secretariat and proposed a DRAFT-1 to the Panel for initial feedback.</li> <li>• DRAFT-1 was presented to TCC-2(2025) and will be further discussed by the Panel in EC-CDP-11.</li> </ul> <p>Note: Draft Resolution 6.1/1 will become “Resolution 9 (EC-79)” in the final report.</p>

<p><u>Resolution 11</u> Business Continuity Management Guidelines</p> <p><u>Requests</u> the technical commissions, in coordination with <b>the Executive Council Capacity Development Panel</b>, to support Members' implementation of Business Continuity Management through the development of practical training materials that cover their critical service areas and the full value chain of warning services in their countries, including private entities such as ICT companies and mass media in order to maintain the Disaster Risk Reduction function at national level in the face of significant events ;</p> <p><u>Requests</u> Regional Associations to include Business Continuity Management training, including through Regional Centres, encouraging cooperation among them , in their workplans, and explore possibilities for peer-to-peer assistance between Members ;</p> <p><u>Requests</u> the Secretary-General to provide the necessary human, financial and technical resources within the approved budgetary provisions:</p> <p>(a) To develop the requested training materials;</p> <p>(b) To publish the guidelines and subsequently developed training materials available in all WMO official languages;</p> <p>(c) To support Regional Associations in need to organise trainings in Business Continuity Management;</p>	<p>In progress</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Focal point: Cyrille Honoré</li> <li>• ET-GO update: A TT has been set up in the secretariat to work on the development of BCM training and they will seek the CDP's guidance. - (2) Keep the strong efforts on building and nurturing networks of women scientists and technical experts as well as invest in their capacity;
- (3) To share the results of these efforts with members through presentations or case studies;
- (4) Ensure regional and gender balance and inclusiveness in all structures and work plans as provided in their terms of reference;
- (5) Report to the Executive Council and to Congress on progress;

- Agreed conclusions 4 - ToR viii “*Provide guidance regarding WMO efforts in gender equality and youth engagement*” will be continuously considered as part of workplan of ET-EPC.
- Agreed conclusion 6 - The EC-CDP will advise the SYMET organizing committee to include gender discussions in the Agenda of SYMET-15 and will consider organizing a side event dedicated to this important topic.
